


In Office 2007 or later:

Save your files as .pdf

Using .pdf files is a great way of sharing documents and eliminating the recipient's ability to easily change your document. Also, anyone can open a .pdf file – they don't need Microsoft Word (or your version of Word) to do it. Just download and install the **Save as PDF or XPS** add-in from Microsoft one time, then you can Save As PDF anytime you like.

2. After you install the **Save as PDF or XPS** add-in, you can choose “Save As” then “PDF or XPS” from the Office button  in the upper left corner of Word, Excel, etc.
